

Lakeside Elementary School Building Highlights – 2015/2016

Student Achievements

- United States Department of Education Nomination as a "National Blue Ribbon School."
- Lakeside Harry Potter Reading Club every Tuesday with 25-40 students attending weekly culminating with the district-wide Yule Ball.
- In its 9th consecutive year, Lakeside Chess Team meets every Tuesday and Thursday after school with over 80 participants from grades K-5. In mid-March, 14 Chess Club members represented Lakeside at the Michigan Chess Association Elementary and Primary Championships returning with three 1st place trophies and seven medals. At the State Tournament on March 26, 2016, Lakeside teams won two 1st place team trophies for two different age divisions, a fifth place team trophy as well as two gold and two silver medals for individual match placements.
- Arwen Crosby and Cooper Hutt represented Lakeside at the Regional Spelling Bee in February. Cooper Hutt won the Regional Spelling Bee and advanced to the Greater Grand Rapids Spelling Bee on March 22, 2016, where he placed 11th overall.
- Veteran's Day Assembly featuring our choir honoring over 45 invited veterans and their families as well as eight large boxes of gathered donations for the Grand Rapids Home for Veterans.
- Math Teams in the 3rd-5th Grades with 49 3rd graders, 50 4th graders and 42 5th graders participating this year. Lakeside 3rd and 4th grades each won their respective Online Math League National Championships this year. These teams have won a combined seven National Championships in the past 17 years.
